From Digital Editions to Interpretive Insights: Reimagining Čiurlionis's Music Legacy

Summary: This study presents the culmination of a 2022-2024 project dedicated to creating a comprehensive digital critical edition of Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis's (1875-1911) piano music, along with plans for future research and development work (2025-2028) incorporating vocal music and creating a separate analysis module.

LEGACY OF ČIURLIONIS

Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis is internationally recognized more as a painter than as a musician, largely due to exhibitions after his 1911 death and recent exhibitions in major cities. His musical contributions, including early serial music examples, remain underappreciated globally because publication began 50 years after his death, with limited distribution during Soviet occupation of Lithuania (1944-1990).

- c. 500 music compositions (including drafts)
- early period is influenced by romantic style while late period had features of modern music
- musical works are closely tied to paintings (it is speculated that he had synesthesia)
- all forms of symmetry used in structure and texture of late compositions as well as experiments in serial compositional technique are unique in the European music history of XX century




