

### The Corpus

- ca. 2,000 pieces up to date (planned <u>3,000</u> by October 2024)
  - 18<sup>th</sup>-century opera seria arias
  - Pietro Metastasio: Didone abbandonata,
    Demofoonte, Alessandro nell'Indie, Artaserse,
    Adriano in Siria
- 2 symbolic formats: musicXML and MuseScore
- Musescore files contain:
  - Harmonic annotations
  - Metadata: Date, Composer, Dramma, Act & scene, Character
- Accompanying database:
  - Emotional label (Descartes)
  - Original clef, dramatic role
  - Theatre and place of premiere
  - 1st singers
  - Critical apparatus for each aria, etc.

#### Creation

- Musicological curation
- Selection of sources and editorial criteria
  - Princeps manuscript
  - Homogeneous editorial criteria
  - Computer readability
- Engraving:
  - 10-phase process (4 stages of revision)
  - +10 people
- Harmonic annotations for each aria (following DCML standard)
  Digital scores




#### Uniqueness


- Scope: +80 years
- Variety of formats
- Harmonic annotations for each file
- Cognate emotional labels
- Richness of metadata: added musicological value
